The communication should show student ownership of the learning, based on meaningful learning experiences, and demonstrate different ways of knowing. The government only requires that the last communication be in writing.

The teachers at Pearson Road Elementary want to communicate with you in the most effective ways possible. This year, our reporting will provide more opportunities for you to see your child's learning in action and for you to talk to the teacher about your child's progress. Here is what you will be seeing this year:

September 27, 2018	Open House/Interview	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Meet the teacher</li><li>- Find out class routines and culture</li><li>- Communicate parent concerns</li></ul>
December 7, 2018	Checklist	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Progress report based on learning goals</li></ul>
January 24, 25, 2019	Teacher Conference	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Discuss student progress</li><li>- Outline concerns by teacher or parent</li><li>- Students to demonstrate and share their learning</li><li>- Develop plan and goals for the remainder of the year</li></ul>
April 11, 2019	Student Led Conference	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Students demonstrate and share their learning</li><li>- Review goals and plans</li><li>- Determine any further goals or concerns</li></ul>
June 27, 2019	Summary Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Communicate student progress for the year based on learning goals and grade expectations.</li></ul>
