Social and emotional skills are important for both children and adults to build and maintain healthy relationships and to develop a strong and balanced sense of self. These skills are vital in school and the workplace. SEL can help children:

- Manage stress
- Improve relationships with family, friends, and peers
- · Find healthy ways to communicate their needs
- · Control their emotions
- Increase social engagement
- Promote the well-being of themselves and others
- · Increase their academic success

ACCIDENT INSURANCE:

Central Okanagan Public Schools does not insure expenses for student injuries that occur on school grounds or during school activities. Parents and guardians can voluntarily purchase private accident insurance. The Kids Plus Accident Insurance Program that was previously offered to our students was discontinued in 2019.

The IA Financial Group now offers the Family Accident Reimbursement Plan (FARP), which is a voluntary plan that provides coverage for students and their families against accidental injury, unexpected medical expenses and critical illness.
