May was a busy and enriching month filled with hands-on learning experiences both in our community and outdoors. Our class had the opportunity to visit the Ellison Club House, where students participated in activities in the forest classroom, animal classroom, and mud kitchen. These experiences encouraged curiosity, exploration, and a deeper connection with the natural environment.

We also visited the Laurel Packinghouse to learn about pollinators in the Okanagan. Students explored the important role that bees play in local agriculture and food production, while gaining an appreciation for the diversity of pollinators found in our region.

Another exciting excursion took us to the Rotary Centre for the Arts, where students learned a variety of hula hoop techniques and tricks. This engaging workshop promoted creativity, coordination, and active participation.

Back at school, students have been busy working in our community garden. They learned about the process of preparing a garden bed and experienced firsthand the effort required to create a successful growing space. Students then planted a Three Sisters garden, a traditional companion planting method that combines corn, beans, and squash. Through this activity, they learned how different plants can work together to support one another and create a healthy, productive garden ecosystem.

The garden's mud kitchen has also remained a favorite learning space, providing opportunities for imaginative play, collaboration, and sensory exploration.

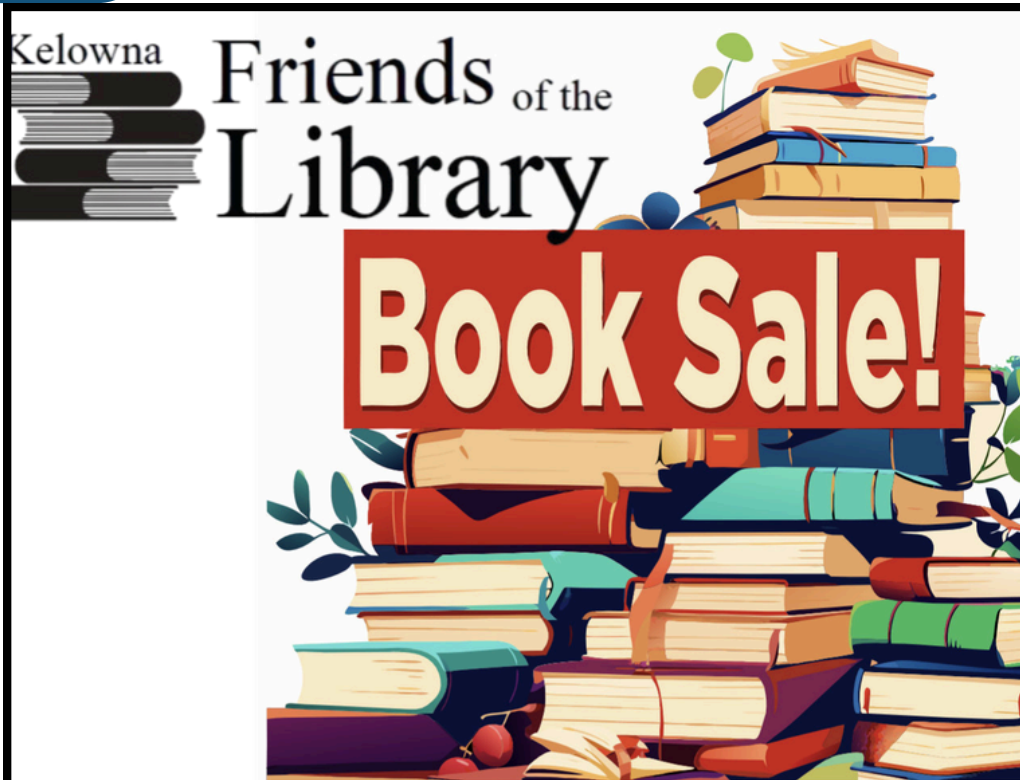
