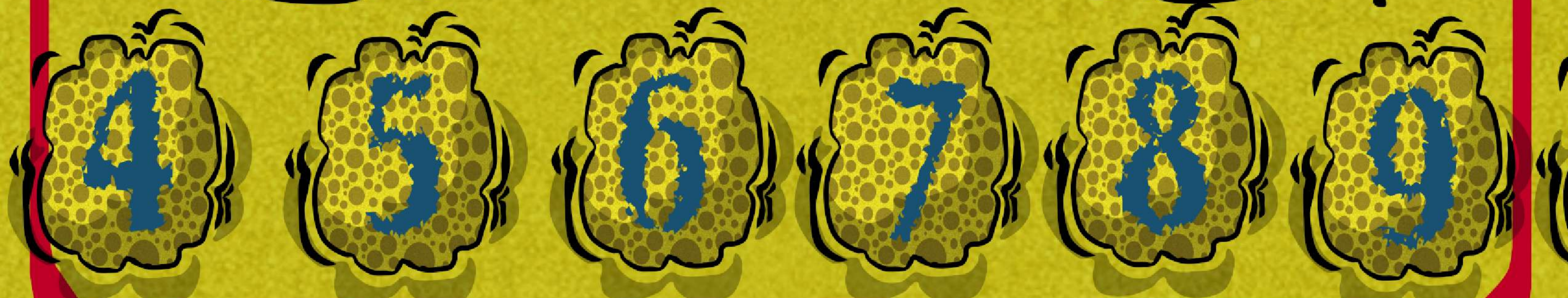

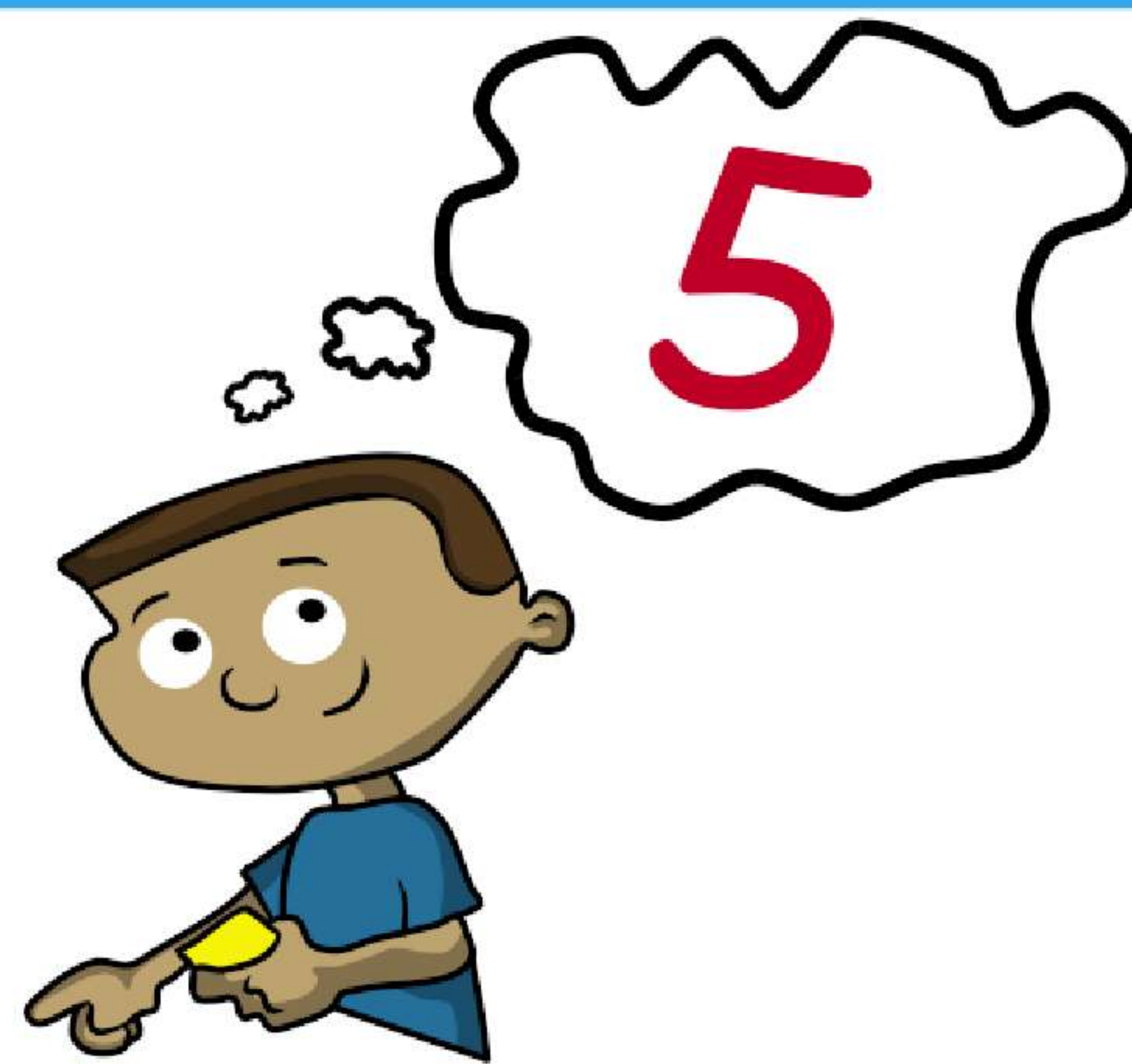

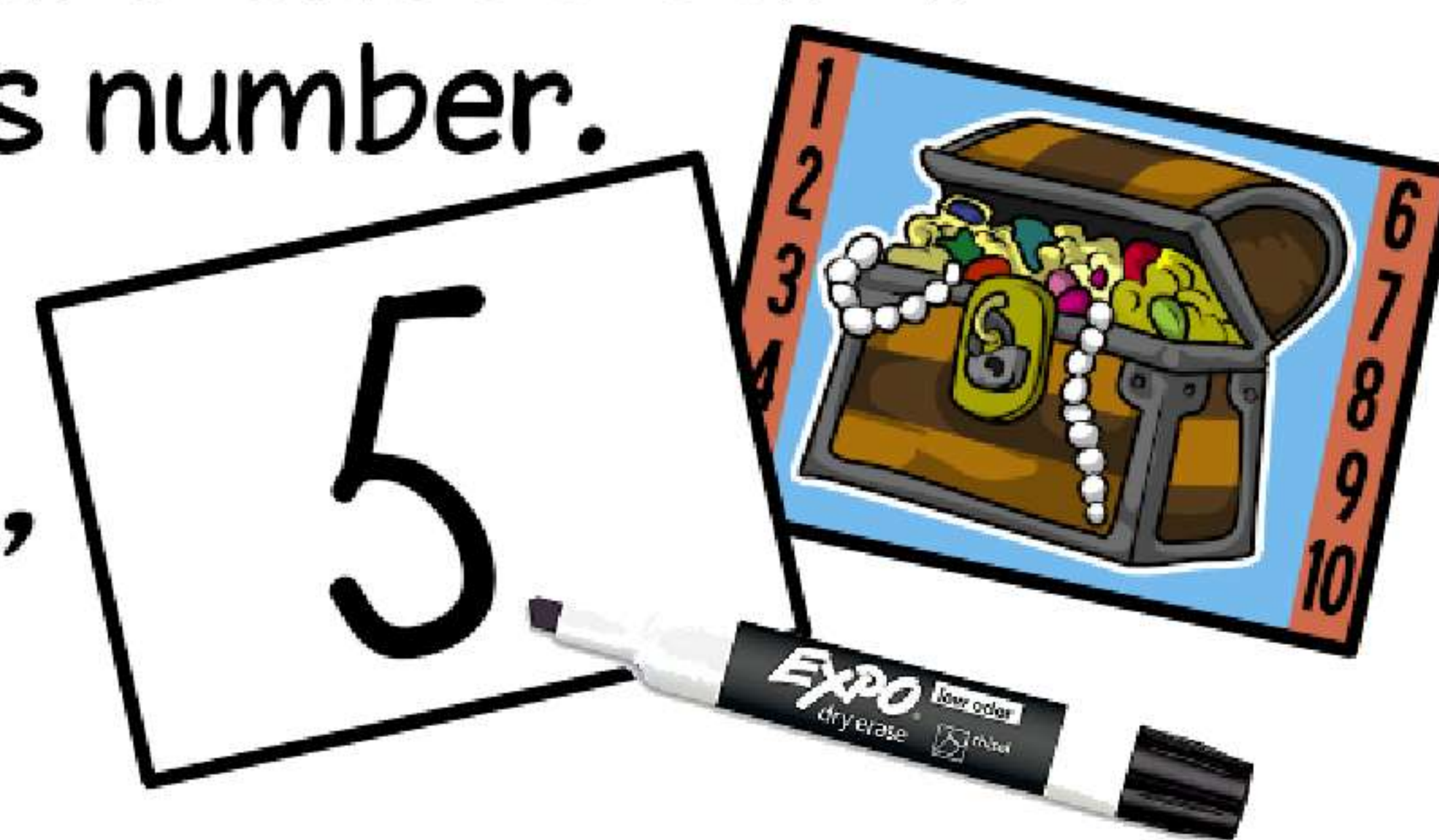
NUMBER LINE PIRATES

Set Up:



- Player 1 will "bury the treasure chest"
- He/she chooses a "mystery number" and uses the marker to write it on the back of the treasure chest card. The other players should not see this number.

- Place the "too small" and "TOO BIG" pirates at each end of the number line, facing each other.



How to Play:

- The other players try to dig up the "hidden treasure" by guessing which mystery number it is buried under.
- Player 1 says whether the number guessed is "TOO BIG" or "too small" and covers the guessed number with the appropriate pirate card (The "too small" pirate covers the number if the guess was smaller than the Mystery Number; the "TOO BIG" pirate covers the number if the guess was bigger than the Mystery Number).
- Players keep guessing and moving the pirates until the "mystery number" is guessed! The player that discovers the mystery number wins (!) and gets to hide the treasure chest next.
- For an added challenge, add in the "11 - 20" page and choose a mystery number from a larger range of numbers!
