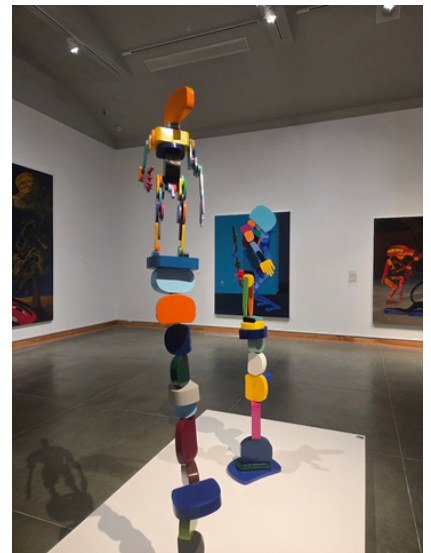
Grade 2 Teacher - Ms. Conne

The class studied the work of Lawrence Paul Yuxweluptun Lets'lo:tseltun, a Syilx and Cowichan artist that draws inspiration from both his Syilx and Cowichan heritages. His work uses surrealist, pop art aesthetics to showcase the Okanagan landscape, Coast Salish designs, and stories about the indigenous people of British Columbia.

The best part of the tour was when the class had the opportunity to become artists themselves. The students used simple shapes and bold colours to create their own unique paintings. Everyone had a blast!

We offer summer camps for participants entering grades 1-12. Camps take place at our UBC Okanagan campus in Kelowna and feature 4 and 5-day programs packed with hands-on experiments, creative building challenges, and engaging STEM activities.

Our camps for students entering Grade 1 are designed to build confidence and curiosity through playful exploration of science and engineering. Older students can dive into topics like coding, robotics, and video game design, while developing problem-solving and teamwork skills. High school participants have opportunities to explore advanced STEM topics and post-secondary pathways.
